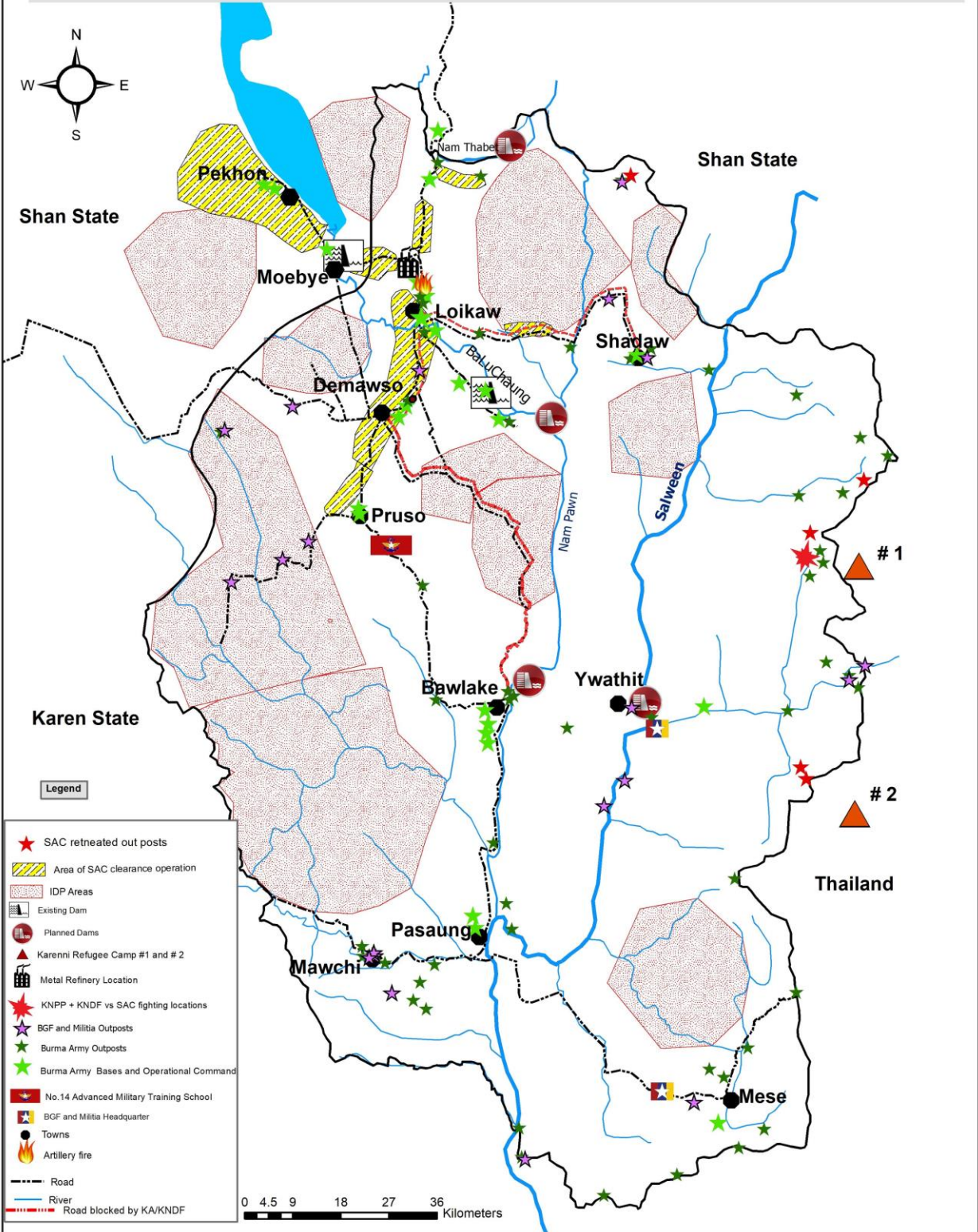

Location of SAC operations and human rights violations Dec 19, 2022 - Jan 1, 2023

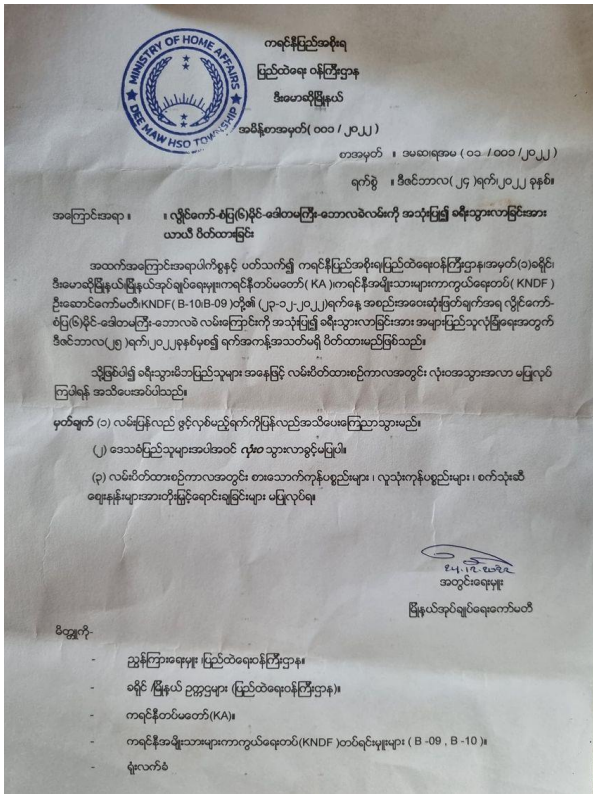


SAC fires shells indiscriminately in Loikaw amid tank and troop build-up in Demawso

During the last week of December, the SAC sent tanks and troop reinforcements to Demawso along the Loikaw-Demawso and Demawso-Moebye main roads. On December 20, fighter jets flew several times over Loikaw and Phekon township. On December 23, fighter jets flew over eastern Demawso township. To block the SAC from sending supplies to their front lines, the KA and KNDF have since December 25 closed the main road between Loikaw and Bawlakeh via 6 Miles and Dawtamagi.

On December 20, a 40-year-old widow who had been displaced for over one year from Seledone village, Demawso township, committed suicide due to depression and poor health.

On December 24, the Karenni Government's Demawso township administration chief, in coordination with the KA and KNDF, released a statement announcing that no one was allowed to travel or transport goods along the road between Loikaw-Sanpya 6 Miles-Dawtamagi-Bawlake from December 25 onwards. It stated that until notice of re-opening, civilians were strictly forbidden from using the road, and prices of food products, consumer goods and petrol should not be increased during the road closure.

On December 26, at around 8pm, although there was no fighting, SAC indiscriminately fired artillery shells into Lwehtamu village, Loikaw, damaging one house and injuring a 50-year-old man in his right arm.

On December 31, at around 11 am, three different SAC military camps east of the Salween - namely Ayekone camp, 2888 camp, and Karkay camp -- were attacked by KA drones and snipers. The number of SAC casualties is not yet confirmed. KA troops retreated safely after the attacks.
