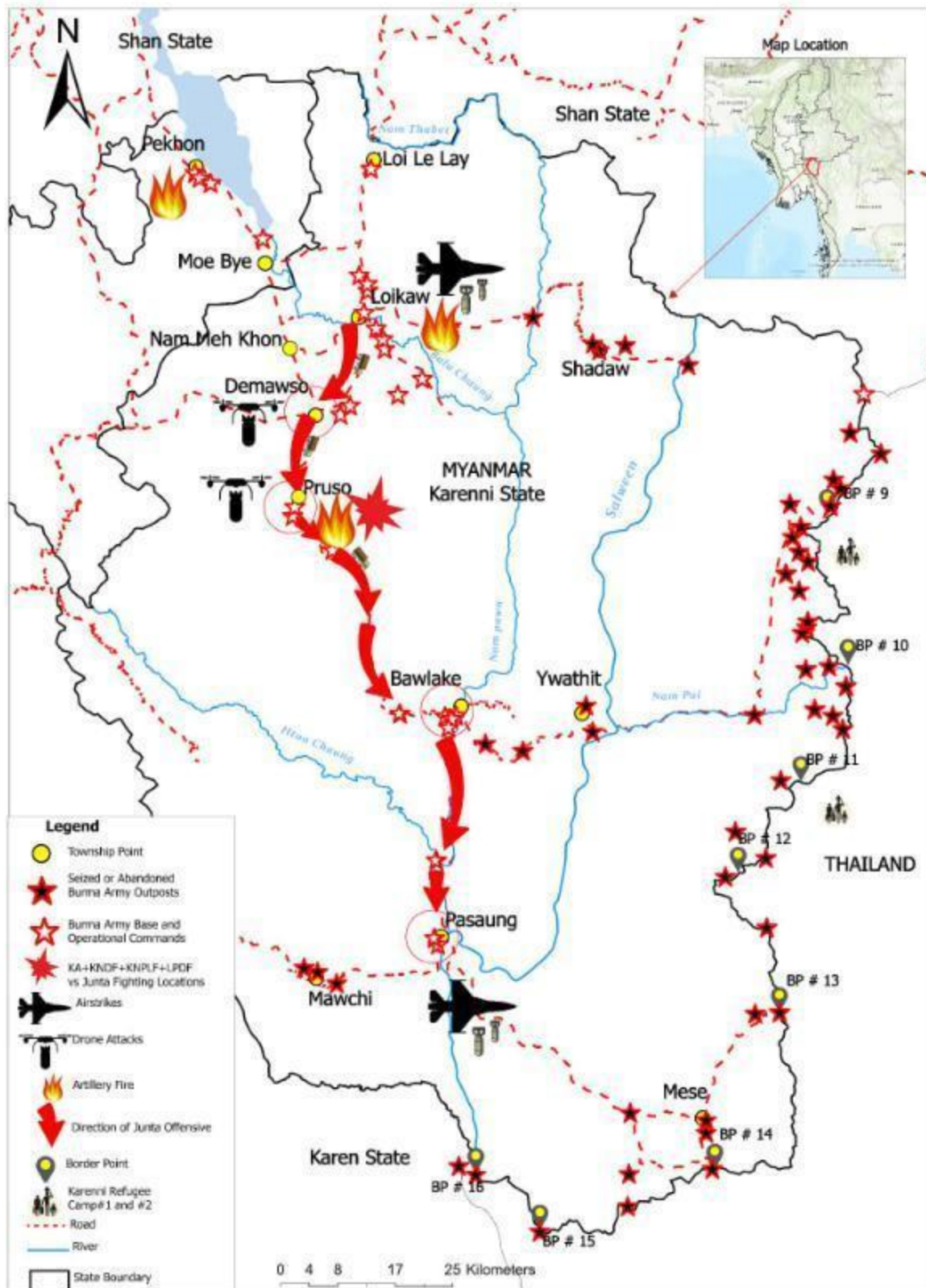

Junta airstrikes, shooting and drone bombings kill three civilians, injure five in Pasaung, Pruso and Loikaw townships

Throughout July, the junta military council has been conducting increased drone surveillance along the Union Road between Demawso and Pruso, which is now under their control. During the last week of July, the junta and its militia ally, the Pa-O National Organization, have been involved in combat close to villages west of Moe Bye on the Shan-Karenni border and Daw Nga Kha village, west of Demawso town, resulting in significant civilian displacement. Due to the conflict conditions in the Moe Bye region, combined revolutionary forces have announced that civilians should avoid using the Loi Yin Taung-chay, Loi Waing, and Khas San roads in the west of Moe Bye. In July, junta airstrikes, drone bombings and shooting in Pasaung, Pruso and Loikaw townships resulted in the death of three civilians, while injuring five others.

Timeline of conflict incidents during July

On July 8, at around 12 pm, a kamikaze drone belonging to the junta landed in the western part of Demawso, scattering bombs about 100 feet away. This terrifying sight has caused concern among the public around that region.

On July 14, the junta carried out airstrikes on three areas east of Loikaw, killing a woman in her 50s who was hit by a bomb, damaged 5 houses and two cars.

On July 15, the junta targeted a pedestrian crossing in the town of Pruso with a drone strike, killing a 49-year-old man and injuring another.

On July 16, at around 3 pm, a 20-year-old man was killed and two others were seriously injured when the junta launched an aerial attack on a location in the town of Pasaung. In addition, a car, a boat and many other goods worth more than 1.7 billion kyat were destroyed.

On July 21, two displaced people were chased and shot at by junta troops in an area in Pruso township while herding cattle. A 19-year-old displaced person was injured in the arm while a 45-year-old man is still missing.

Since the third week of July, junta troops have been conducting more heavy weapon attacks and drone reconnaissance in and around the village of Loi Waing, west of Moebye on the Shan-Karenni border, causing local residents to abandon their fields and flee.

In July, similar to the previous month, junta troops continued to carry out drone surveillance and fire heavy weaponry in villages and rice paddies in Pruso township.

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
